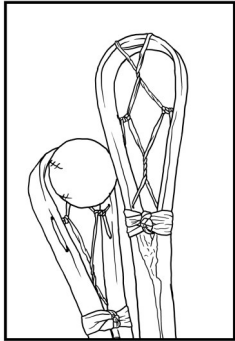
Sequoyah's Syllabary

Sequoyah created the Cherokee Syllabary without ever learning how to read or write in English.

Each symbol represents a syllable sound in the Cherokee language. The word for Cherokee in the language is **Ja-La-Gi**, so it would be written **CWY** in syllabary.
